You can pay by bank transfer. **Quote your 8 digit account number** only (with no additional text), and use the **sort code 57-93-64** and **account number 04579364**.



You can also pay by cash or card at any **Post**Office. Take your bill with you. Use the sort code

57-93-64 and account number 04579364.
