- 7. Ensure all children are engaged in suitable activities. Be pro-active and vigilant regarding any situations that may be a cause for concern e.g. bullying or children isolated from mainstream activities. Take appropriate action to resolve these issues and report them to the supervisor.
- 8. Observe Health and Safety regulations relating to the school at all times.
- 9. Retain the confidentiality on all aspects of school life
- 10. Any other duties that reasonably fall within the purview of the post which may be allocated after consultation with the postholder
