(30mph Speed Limit) Order 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wokingham Borough Council ("the Council"), in order to improve road safety and facilitate the passage of traffic, proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 81, 82, 83, 84 and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Act 1984 as amended and Regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 (SI 1996/2489) and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to formally introduce 30mph speed limit along parts of A329 Reading Road (Winnersh), A329 Reading Road (Wokingham), A329 London Road (Wokingham), Hollow Lane (Shinfield), A327 Arborfield Road (Shinfield), Bearwood Road (Barkham), A327 Reading Road (Finchampstead), New Mill Lane (Finchampstead) and Park Lane (Finchampstead).

The Order also seeks to revoke in whole or in part of the following orders:

Revoke Whole Order: Royal County of Berkshire (40mph Speed Limit) (No.7) Order 1962
Revoke Part: Bracknell Forest Borough Council (A329/B3408 London Road, Bracknell/Wokingham) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1999.

Revoke Part: Wokingham District Council (A327 Shinfield Road, A327 Hollow Lane, A327 Arborfield Road, and Brookers Hill Shinfield) (30 and 40mph Speed Limits) Order 2006.

Revoke Part: Wokingham Borough Council (Various Roads, Wokingham Borough) (30, 40 and 50 mph speed limits) Order 2016.
